Competition Conditions of Entry

- 1. Rules:** The Junior Grand Slam Challenge competitions will be conducted in accordance with the Picton & Camden Tennis Centres. The Competition committee shall have the entire control and management of the events and their decision in any dispute shall be final.
 - 2. Tennis NSW & Hot Shots Membership:** All players must be registered with Tennis NSW or can pay for membership by using the form available on www.tennisnsw.com.au. These competitions are for registered players only & i.e. if a player is not registered with the Tennis Australia their entry will not be accepted.
 - 3. Entry Fees:** Must accompany all entries and be lodged with your club's coach by the closing date. Details for where entries and fees are to be sent to are outlined on the 1st page of this form.
 - 4. Events:** Players may enter 1 singles and 1 doubles event only. Players entering doubles events may play with a boy or girl partner.
 - 5. Age Eligibility:** is as follows. Entries are open to players who are of or under the age for their respective events at midnight 31st December, 2018. Players may enter a higher age group if they wish, however if they have earned points from a different aged event, their points will not carry over into the other aged events.
 - 6. Seedings and Player Ability:**
 - i. The competition organiser will determine seedings based on previous events.
 - ii. To compete in the red events players should be able to serve underarm (drop serve) and be learning the rules of tennis to play this competition (organisers may assist in the scoring of matches).
 - ii. To compete in the 10/U orange events players must be able to serve the ball over the head. If players double fault they are allowed to do a forehand (drop serve) to start the point on the 3rd attempt. If they fault again then the point is awarded to the receiver.
 - 7. Matches:** All events will be round robin format. Finals will be played for each event.
 - 8. Withdrawals:** Players who withdraw or don't show up at the event will forfeit their entry fee unless a medical certificate is provided or a legitimate reason is provided for not participating.
 - 9. Attire:** Correct Tennis attire must be worn in all events.
 - 10. Umpiring:** Any player may be required to umpire at the direction of the organisers of the event.
 - 11. Be Ready To Play:**
 - i. All players should turn up ready to play and be signed in 20mins prior to the event starting.
 - ii. Players should have a hat, sunscreen and appropriate clothing to perform physical activity.
 - iii. In case of inclement weather, activities will be conducted. If after an hour, if play has not commenced a decision will be made whether the event will be postponed or cancelled.
 - 12. Privacy Statement:** Your Personal information will only be used in accordance with the purposes of Tennis Australia and the Picton & Camden Tennis Clubs.
 - 13. Publicity Statement:**
 - i. Photographs and results maybe used to promote the events for publicity purposes, without compensation.
 - ii. Please inform the organiser before the matches commence if you do not want your child's photo published.
 - 14. Adjustments**
 - i. The organisers of the event reserve the right to reduce, or re-schedule any matches due to extenuating circumstances.
 - ii. In case of inclement weather, the event will be replayed (date will be confirmed).
- *Please note that these events are a fun participation competition for kids and any child or parent that behaves inappropriately may be asked to leave the event and may ultimately be disqualified from participating in any other future events.
